**Re: Yeovil Western Corridor Improvement Scheme**

To whom it may concern,

I am writing to inform you that the final phase of night time road works will be taking place in Lysander Road between the junction of Lysander Road / Watercombe Lane and Laburnum Way, commencing on 14<sup>th</sup> November.

This is earlier than previously advertised as we have been able to accelerate the programme by completing elements of this phase during the previous phases of works.

This section of road will be closed for approximately two weeks, at night between 8 p.m. and 6 a.m. Mondays to Fridays. This is a shorter duration for this phase than previously advertised. A signed diversion route will be in place and access to Laburnum Way will be maintained from the East. Access for pedestrians and cyclists will be unaffected.

Please be aware that noise levels may be increased during working hours although we will be deploying monitoring equipment to ensure that noise and vibration are kept to a minimum.

These works are to complete the installation of ducting for street lighting, removing the old road surface and laying the new surface, including the installation of sensors within the carriageways for traffic lights.

We apologise in advance for any inconvenience these works may cause and will endeavour to keep disruption to a minimum.
